Monthly Newsletter



- 2- The next event will be the Matanzas Inlet-Steak Bake to be held June 20, 2014. The lead for this event is Kate Nelson. All boats involved will meet on the ICW in front of the Palm Coast Marina canal at 1000hrs, and proceed to the inlet. Unlike last year, we should be having the event on a rising tide to prevent grounding issues. We will use the first beach, not the one around the curve of the island.



For those coming by car, park at the inlet parking area and a pontoon boat will ferry you across; be there between noon and 12:30 PM. 
