

1. Bowline








2. Cleat Hitch - Note you start with the line on the "far" end of the cleat (Farthest from your boat). I have seen many of our mates tie this incorrectly with too many unneeded wraps. Tie it correctly and it holds fast but is easy to untie.




- **3. Clove Hitch-** Use them for tasks like hanging coils of line for neat stowage, or <u>securing</u> fenders so they hang down from a bowrail.
- 4. Half Hitch and the perhaps more useful double half hitch:
